Mr. Daniel C. Himelspach is a co-founder and principal in Dispute Management, Inc., a full service provider of dispute resolution services. He has practiced law in Colorado since 1976 with an emphasis on litigation and business matters. He has operated Dispute Management since 1990. He received training in negotiation, arbitration and mediation from Harvard Law School in 1990 and advanced training in 2004.
